At-A-Glance

- **11.7 miles** from East Falls Church to Wiehle Avenue in Reston.
- Construction began March 2009, now **94** percent complete.
- Aerial bridges, track work done.
- Finishing touches on systems, stations, pedestrian bridges and pavilions almost done.
- Testing underway.
- Construction completion anticipated September 2013.
- Commuter Parking at Wiehle-Reston East; Kiss-and-Ride lots, bus and taxi drops at McLean, Spring Hill and Wiehle-Reston East.
- Opening date to be set by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority.
- **Dulles Transit Partners** is Design Build contractor.

Who is Building Dulles Rail

Construction is being managed by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority. When completed, the project will be turned over to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) and become part of the existing Metro system.

Reston Town Center Herndon Innovation Center Dulles Airport Route 606 Ashburn (Route 772)

At-A-Glance

- 11.4 miles from Wiehle-Reston East through Dulles Airport to Ashburn in eastern Loudoun County.
- Commuter parking at Herndon, Innovation Center, Route 606 and Route 772/Ashburn stations. There is no commuter parking at Reston Town Center or Dulles Airport stations.
- All stations are above ground. Dulles Airport is aerial.
- Capital Rail Constructors awarded design-build contract in April 2013.

Construction – Phase 2

- Phase 2 notice to proceed: July 8, 2013.
- Coming soon: surveying, geo-tech work, site preparation, permitting.
- Heavy construction: Spring 2014.
- Project will then be turned over to WMATA to operate and set date for opening.
- Construction completion is anticipated in July 2018.
