BRACELETS

PUPPETS

Team members share the Gospel story with thousands of adults and children each year using our witness tools. Both the bracelets and puppets bridge the language barriers and become treasured possessions. You can share the Gospel of Jesus by helping MOST Ministries make these witness tools.

Materials:

- One strip of leather 16 and 1/2 inches long by 1/8 inches wide
- Colored pony beads: clear, grey, red, white, blue, green, and yellow

Instructions:

- String the beads onto the leather strip in the following order: grey, red, white, blue, green, yellow.
- 2. Center the beads on the leather strip and tie a knot on each end of the group of beads. This will help to hold them in place.
- 3. Take the clear bead and string one of the leather ends through it. Take the other end of leather and start it into the hole in the bead (entering in the opposite direction).
- Tie a knot on each end of leather.
 The clear bead will allow you to adjust the bracelet to fit any wrist.

Materials:

- J Crochet Hook
- 4-ply yarn gray, red, white, blue, green, and yellow

Instructions for the Head:

Using any color yarn, ch 3, sl st to form circle. Ch 1, 6 sc in circle, sc in ch 1 around until head measures 1.5 inches. Sl st to end.

Instructions for the Legs:

Using each color of yarn, make one leg of each color. Attach yarn to head in order (grey, red, white, blue, green, yellow). Crochet leg chain 3 inches long, using 2 strands of yarn.
