Materials Needed:

J Crochet Hook 4-ply yarn: grey, red, white, blue, green, and yellow

Instructions:

Head: Using any color yarn, ch 3, sl st to form circle. Ch 1, 6 sc in circle. Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Repeat until head measures 1.5 inches. Sl st to end.

Legs: Using each color of yarn make one leg of each color. Attach yarn to head in order (grey, red, white, blue, green, yellow). Crochet leg chain 3 inches long, using 2 strands of yarn.

Meaning of the Colored Legs:

Gray - We are separated from God by our sin (Rom 3:23). Red - Because God loves us, He sacrificed His Son, Jesus, for our sin (Rom 5:8). White - Now God sees us as righteous, pure and forgiven of sin (Eph 1:7-8). Blue - We are baptized into the family of God through baptism (Gal 3:26-27). Green - We read the Bible and pray to grow in faith & disciple others (2 Peter 3:18a). Yellow - We will receive the crown of life (Rev 2:10b).
